12.13.19 Email	<p>Announced</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Selection Criteria for Consolidating Schools Participating in Cross-Functional Monitoring – announced FSP would use the same schools</li> <li>● IIIA and IVA Intent and Purpose can be met across the LEA and not in each individual school</li> <li>● Flexibility in file preparation – can be prepared by school and contain multiple indicators</li> <li>● Focus on demonstration of meeting schoolwide plan and not expenditures</li> <li>● Onsite support for monitoring</li> </ul>
11.25.19 Email	<p>Announced Title I, Part C Flexibilities Under Consolidation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● USDE confirms that for K-12 migrant youth attending those schools where funds are consolidated, the LEA will not collect or report supplemental services for those students. The LEA will still collect and report for Preschool Children, Out of School Youth (OSY), Drop Out Students (DO), and any K-12 migrant youth not attending consolidated schools.</li> <li>● LEAs do not have to complete and submit implementation plans for K-12 migrant youth in consolidated schools <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Migrant student progress is incorporated into Title I, Part C Consolidation LEA Plan due annually prior to budget approval.</li> <li>○ The effectiveness of schoolwide plans are an indicator reviewed in LEA monitoring, generally occurring every four years.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Title I, Part C migrant staff will not complete onsite observations of interventions targeted for K-12 migrant youth at consolidated schools.</li> </ul>
11.18.19 Email	<p>Announced</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Further clarification on Title I, Part A Supplemental Services Notification to Parents of EL Students (OCR notification required) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Scenario 1: LEAs are not required to issue a second notification in schools consolidating Title I, Part A that do not receive Title III, Part A.</li> <li>○ Scenario 2: LEAs are not required to issue a second notification in schools consolidating Title I, Part A and Title III, Part A.</li> <li>○ Scenario 3: LEAs ARE required to issue a second notification in schools consolidating Title I, Part A, but not Title III, Part A.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Confirmation from USDE that in schools that consolidate Title III, Part A, all ELs whose parents do not opt out of language services should be counted as receiving supplemental services.</li> <li>● New Funding Sources – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ SIGA – Rural Resources &amp; GA Systems of Continuous Improvement (GSCI)</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Evidenced-Based documentation is not required for SIGA funds</li> <li>● Monitoring Updates</li> </ul>
